Welcome to Season 27 of the Aactive Dart League. Leagues are offered in Winnipeg, Brandon, Beausejour, Stonewall & Portage La Prairie.

In total, 14 teams won trips to Team Dart (12 from the Winnipeg Vegas Leagues & 2 from Portage La Prairie). Six Pink Ladies teams participated in South Dakota, & we held our own Pink Ladies Tournament in November. Other tournaments held last year was Team Cricket, NYE Blind Draw, 501 Team in Portage La Prairie, and the Pink Ladies Mixed Triples.

NEW this year is the Wednesday Night CA\$H League & a new addition to our Vegas Leagues - PREMIER VEGAS on Thursday Nights. We still offer the other 4 Vegas leagues (with divisions as needed), Pink Ladies Doubles & Mixed Doubles and Elite (with A & B divisions). Plans are in the works for some short Remote Doubles Leagues where you can play out of your home bar, and a possible return to our Junior (kids) League. Information for these leagues and more are in this e-newsletter.

New locations have also been added.

NDA Team Dart is May 7-13, 2026. Due to Easter, our Winnipeg Vegas & Ca\$h Leagues will start August 26-28. If you want to play and your team cannot make the first week, do not worry. Just let us know and we will reschedule those matches for a later date.

Winnipeg Vegas Playoffs will take place January 9-11 & 16-18, 2026. The Season-End Playoffs are March 20-22 & 27-29, with the "Singles Blitz" taking place between the March Playoff weekends.

Six Ladies teams participated in South Dakota (Oct), 13 Ladies teams played in our own Pink Tournament (Nov) and 24 triples teams in the Mixed Triples (May). Ladies teams are planning for South Dakota this October. Let's make this the best Pink year ever!

The 10 week Fall season starts September 8. Teams can be 2 ladies or Mixed (female/male) in separate leagues. There are NO Playoffs for the Winnipeg Pink leagues. A pot luck and fun darts is planned for each Pink Season End windup. No experience needed to play.

Winnipeg Pink Ladies Annual Meeting is 7pm, Wednesday August 20 @ Rookies. The ladies encourage your ideas, questions & comments. Feel free to reach out in advance to wpgpinkladies@gmail.com Fall Pink Doubles registrations will be accepted.

The Pink Ladies Tab Fund was a challenge accepted after the SD Pink State Tournament last October. The goal was to fill a water jug with can tabs. Mission accomplished many times over! The WPL are pleased to announce that anyone can drop off their can tabs, pop cans or any metal at Western Scrap Metals - 18 Sutherland Ave and put it on the Winnipeg Pink Ladies account (please separate tabs from the cans). You can still drop off tabs at any Playoff or Tournament.

Monies raised from league fees & fundraising go into the Winnipeg Pink Ladies Presentation Fund. Winnipeg Pink Ladies have Non-Profit Charity status.

Since 2014, their presentations have included dart players, friends, families, coworkers and individuals receiving cancer treatments.

Three 10 week Pink leagues are offered; Fall, Winter & Summer. Ladies that play in our Pink leagues this year are eligible to participate in the South Dakota Pink Ladies State Dart Tournament October 2026 in Brookings South Dakota.

HISTORY: Pink Ladies was founded by Randy "Mr. Pink" Oliver of Yankton South Dakota and we are the first official International Pink Ladies League outside of the USA.

Randy did a Pink Ladies Presentation at a Dart Conference the Summer of 2014. That Fall (September), we had our first Pink Ladies Doubles League. In 2018, we opened up the league to include Mixed Teams.

The South Dakota Tournament has grown from 88 doubles teams in 2013 to over 190 ladies teams (4 ladies per team) from various US states and Winnipeg. Our first team participated in 2015 in this fun & emotional event.

NEW THIS YEAR!

- WINNIPEG VEGAS LEAGUES: All Winnipeg Vegas Leagues will have an increase of \$1 per player each week. The Vegas Trip Winners from both Playoff & Draw will now receive \$4000 per team (up from \$3600 / team), plus their Team '01 &/or Team Cricket event at Team Dart. Any extra monies will be added to the Season End Playoffs.
- PLAYERS AWARDS NIGHT: <u>All teams in good standing at the end of the Regular Season (all matches paid &/or played)</u> will be entered in their leagues' Team Cash Draws at the Players Awards Night. This will now include those teams that did not participate in their Vegas or Season End Playoffs.
 - ♦ The Team Cash Draws will be \$20 per team added for each League or Division to a maximum of \$200.
 - ♦ All regular players that attend will be entered for all Player Draws.
 - Teams that do not participate in the Vegas Playoffs will not be entered in the Vegas Draws.
 - ♦ Teams that do not participate in the Season End Playoffs will not receive any payout monies.
- Wednesday Night CASH LEAGUE: This league is offered for those that do not want to play for Vegas or as an option for another night of play. Teams will only play for Cash, Player Awards & Trophies. Players can still get their 96 games in to qualify for Team Dart 2026. Leagues & divisions will be based on # of teams.
 - ♦ Team Cap will be 80.00 PPD. Open to all players. A minimum of 6 teams will be required for each league.
 - ♦ 4 player teams with a 13 game or 15 game format of '01 & Cricket (depending on division).
 - ♦ CA\$H PAYOUTS to all Teams, with 1st place in A division \$1500 and 1st place in B division \$1000
 - ♦ For year 1, handicaps may be used in the Playoffs. If so, they will be adjusted accordingly.
- ◆ Thursday Night PREMIER VEGAS: An additional league to our Thursday night Vegas lineup. Deadline to register will be August 12.
 - ♦ Team Cap will be 100.00 PPD. Players ranked 0 must play in this league. Cost is \$25 per player each week.
 - ♦ A minimum of 6 teams will be required for this league.
 - ♦ If only 4 or 5 teams register, teams will play in Super Vegas as an additional division.
 - Less than 4 teams will require those teams to fit under the Super Vegas 95.00 ppd cap.
 - ♦ Vegas trip(s) will be awarded based on # of teams.
 - More detailed information will be emailed out.
- ♦ **TOURNAMENTS:** For all Tournaments, a players current League PPD or 2025-26 Player Rankings PPD, whichever is higher, will be used. Each tournament will have their own registration criteria. Any player ranked 0 or 1 may not be allowed to play below the top division/level offered.
- **REMOTE LEAGUES:** Remote Doubles or Triples leagues will run 6 or 7 weeks plus playoffs, however, any player games will not count towards Team Dart as the season is not at least 8 separate nights of play as per NDA guidelines.

LEAGUE & PLAYOFF REMINDERS

◆ Team Sign-Ups: It is important to register by the deadline to ensure proper placement of your team.

Teams are entered based on Team PPD and Player Ranking #. Divisions will be used for all Leagues as needed. League & Division placement is based on your teams PPD & individual Player Rankings when you register and will be assigned when the full schedule comes out. Teams will not move up or down for the Playoffs regardless of how well or poorly they play during the season. At seasons end, the top team & players in your League & Division will be awarded 1st place team and player awards.

Any teams signing up after the deadline **may** result in your team being placed in a higher division or league. Teams that cannot play week 1 or 2 will have their match rescheduled. Refer to the Player & Team Caps section for your league. Team name can only be 18 characters (letters, numbers & spaces).

- Spares: If you require a spare on league night, they have to be the same Player Rank or lower. Example- if a player is ranked a 3, you can only use a player ranked a 3 or 4. The rule for adjusting PPD/MPR still applies if the spares average is higher. Using a spare with a higher Player Rank will result in either a loss for every game that player won, then a loss for every game they played in.
- Schedules: Information for your League & Playoff Dates will be at the top of your league schedule. The "NOTES" column will be for makeup matches or double-headers if needed. A scoresheet will be on the last page.
 - We prefer to have all leagues & divisions with an even number of teams for week 1. If not, your league will feature "Byes" and make-up matches (double-headers) so all teams play the same number of matches for the season. The 1st team to even out a league will close registration for that league. Any late team registrations may result in placement in a higher division or league where space allows. We may allow a remote team to even out the # of teams depending on board availability.
- ◆ Regular Roster Players & Spares: For the Vegas Leagues, all Regular Rostered players must have at least 12 weeks (Tuesday teams) and 11 weeks (Thursday teams) to play in the January Vegas Playoffs. If those weeks required are not met, that player will be ineligible to play the entire event. Spares need 5 weeks & be equal or lesser PPD. Spares also need to play in at least 1 round robin match to play the 2nd day. Regular Rostered Players will need 17 weeks to play in the Season End Playoffs or will be ineligible to play. Spares need 8 weeks for the Season-End Playoffs and play at least 1 round robin match before the Elimination round. For all other leagues (unless otherwise stated), regular players need 60% & spares 30% of weeks played. Players need 60% of games played to be eligible for any Player Pin Awards.
- Your weekly fees cover everything related to the league you are playing in.
- Leagues Match Format: On league night, the Home Team will start all odd # games and Away Team will start all even # games.
- ♦ **Vegas Playoffs:** Both round robin & elimination matches will be "Alternate Start" format for games 1 4. This means Home Team will start games 1 & 3 and Away Team will start games 2 & 4. Diddle for last game still applies. Up to 8 teams from each league or league division round robin will advance to double elimination.
- Season End Playoffs: Alternate start format. All teams will receive prize money based on finish.
- Postponing / Cancelling Matches: Please try and find spares instead of postponing matches as rescheduling can become an issue. One option is to contact your opponent to see if they have any spares available. Any outstanding matches must be completed by the last week of play in December to play the Vegas Playoffs in January. Teams can not postpone any matches in January until after your Vegas Playoffs. Any outstanding matches for all Season End Playoffs must be completed by the last week of league play. For matches not played, both teams are required to pay the full amount of league fees and neither team will receive any wins or losses.

2025-26 IMPORTANT NOTES: WINNIPEG VEGAS LEAGUES

COST: Tuesday: Novice Vegas \$15 Intermediate Vegas \$17 Thursday: Open Vegas \$19 Super Vegas \$22 Premier Vegas \$25

Tuesday Team Cap is 74.99ppd (for players ranked 3 or 4). Thursday Team Cap is 100.00ppd (for players ranked 0, 1, 2, 3 or 4). Players ranked 0 must play Premier Vegas. No "new" players (with no stats) allowed to play Premier Vegas.

Premier Vegas requires 6 teams. If only 4 or 5 teams register, teams will play in Super Vegas as an additional division. Less than 4 teams will require those teams to fit under the Super Vegas 95.00 ppd cap.

League & Division placement is based on your teams' PPD & individual Player Ranking & will be assigned when the full schedule comes out. Teams will not move up or down for the Playoffs regardless of how well or poorly they play during the season. At seasons end, the top team & players in your League / Division will be awarded 1st place team and player awards. Vegas trips are determined by the # of team registered for your league / division.

- Matches start at 7:15 PM. There is a 15 minute grace period for late players. If you are missing a player to start, put them in the player 4 position. If they are not present for game 2, push their score through when it is their turn to throw until they arrive.
- Both Team Captains report to the machine for set-up. The HOME TEAM sets their order up first, then the VISITING TEAM.
 All League Fees are paid into the machine before play can begin. Insert your money when the CREDIT SCREEN appears.
 If any bills do not go in after a couple tries, use a different bill. Make sure coins register before inserting another one.
- Some locations have tables directly behind the throw area for those players in the match to place their drinks. If you are not playing, move away from the throw area. <u>Do not use these tables to seat your team on league night</u>. If asked to move, please do so. At other locations, please do not crowd around the boards.
- For teams arriving at the last minute, please find a table and set up the board first so that the match can start on time.
- Players are expected to be at the board when it is their turn to throw.
- Try not to postpone any matches as makeups will need to be played on a different night. Any outstanding matches MUST be caught up by **December 18, 2025** and NO matches can be postponed in January to compete in your leagues' Vegas Playoffs.
- Tuesday & Thursday Vegas League Playoffs will be on separate weekends (both Vegas Playoffs & Season End Playoffs).
- All PLAYOFFS: No handicaps are used in the Vegas and Season End Playoffs. Players need to play in at least 1 round robin match to play in the "Finals" aka elimination bracket. <u>Spares required for the Playoffs must be of equal or lesser ability</u>. If the # of weeks required below are not met, that player will be ineligible to play the entire event.
 - **January Vegas Playoffs:** Regular Rostered players must have at least 12 weeks (Tuesday) and 11 weeks (Thursday) which is the min 96 total games. Spares need 5 weeks from the same league/division.
 - Season End Playoffs: Regular Rostered Players need at least 17 weeks and spares 8 weeks from the same league &/or division.
- SPARES: Enter their FULL NAME (if not assigned to your team). Spares should be of equal or lesser ability & must be the same Player Rank # or lower. Please do not use a higher PPD player replacing a lower PPD player on their 1st night of play. Spares assigned to your team will need to have their PPD/MPR adjusted once they have an average on the stats if subbing for a lower player.
 - A players 1st night of play in any league will have NO Handicap. If their name appears on the stats for that league, enter as required. Incorrect entry of a spares average may lead to wins being credited to the opposing team.
 - Teams are required to find their own spares & have a complete team present. Do not enter a real persons name if you are short a player on league night. If you are missing a player on League night, push the missing players score through.
 - Spares can play for any team in their league/division. Regular players can spare for another team in a different league on the same night provided they do not exceed the player cap or ADL Player Ranking for that league & follow the spare criteria listed above.

This CA\$H League is offered for those that do not want to play for Vegas or as an option for another night of play. This is a great chance to play with friends or new players. 4 player teams with a 13 game or 15 game format of '01 & Cricket (depending on division). CA\$H PAYOUTS to all Teams, with 1st place in A division \$1500 and 1st place in B division \$1000.

Teams will only play for Cash, Player Awards & Trophies. Players can still get their 96 games in to qualify for Team Dart 2026. Leagues & divisions will be based on # of teams.

Cost ranges from \$12 - \$14 per player depending on league / division. Season will be 26-28 weeks.

A minimum of 6 teams will be required for each league. Remote teams may be added if Bullshooter boards are available.

We would like to start this as a fun league. Team Cap will be 80.00 PPD (unless there is interest from a lot of teams) & is open to all players. For year 1, handicaps may be used in the Playoffs. If so, they will be adjusted accordingly.

- Matches start at 7:15 PM. There is a 15 minute grace period for late players. If you are missing a player to start, put them in the player 4 position. If they are not present for game 2, push their score through when it is their turn to throw until they arrive.

NEW A & B divisions will be offered. A minimum of 4 teams per division is required. Otherwise all teams will be in 1 division. Approximate division placement is A division 95-105ppd and B division under 95ppd. Remote teams will be allowed if boards are available.

Play will take place on 6 Saturdays over 5 months between September & January with all matches at Rookies Sports Bar. Each team will play 3 matches per Saturday. Aactive Dart League & Toba Dart players are allowed to participate. Cost is \$33 per player each Saturday.

- 6 Saturdays of play: Regular players must play a minimum of 11 matches to be eligible for all your League Playoffs.
