Important Info For The 2026/27 Season

MID-SEASON TOURNAMENT

Will take place January 8th to 10th, 2027 at the ANAF. Players must have 7 weeks to be qualified to play in the mid-season tournament. The deadline to get your 8 qualifying weeks in by is Friday, January 15th, 2027. That gives you 16 weeks to play 8 qualifying weeks.

2027 WCVNEA CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2027 WCVNEA Championships will be held at the River Cree Hotel & Casino in Edmonton, Alberta on February 10th to 15th, 2027. See poster on page 7.

THURSDAY NIGHT LEAGUE

Total Team CSR Cap is 9400. This numbered is the total of the top 5 CSR players on your team. Only 1 player with a CSR of 1900 or above allowed on a team. The league will be handicapped during the regular season and playoffs. Teams will get 1 point of handicap for every 80 points difference from your opponent.

TEAMS MOVING UP

The 2 teams that played in the finals of the 2026 Year End Playoffs in the Tuesday & Wednesday Leagues, must move up to the next level for one year.

Players that move up to the next level are able to play on a team in one level below their rank, using the following rules:

- Must qualify and play in the playoffs in the higher league.
- Only one player with a higher rank per team.
- Their CSR must be under the maximum established for that league. See poster for maximum CSR number.

SEASON ENDING PLAYOFFS

April 8th to 11th, 2027 at the ANAF.

All players need to play 12 weeks to qualify for the year end playoffs. No exceptions.

LEAGUE FEE PAYMENTS

SANCTION FEES

Sanction fees are \$30. The cost of Sanction Fees increase by \$10.00 on October 1st and increase another \$10.00 on December 1st.

Once a player plays their 3rd match in the league, they are required to pay their sanction fee. No Exceptions. Aactive is invoiced by the VNEA for the players Sanction Fee at this time.

LEAGUE FEES

Teams are responsible for League Fees. It is not up to Aactive to chase individual players for their share! At any time during the season, you can call the league office and check how much your team owes or to make sure that we received your payments.

PAYMENT METHODS

The Aactive office is set up to take payments in the following manner:

Cash, cheque or debit. Debit at office only. Cheques made out to Aactive Coin.

Credit Cards can be used to pay league fees. Aactive charges a 3% usage fee.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I join more than one league?

Absolutely! Many players choose to participate in multiple leagues to expand their experience and meet more people. Just be mindful of scheduling to avoid conflicts.

What equipment do I need?

Locations provide house cues and chalk, but serious players often bring their own gear. If you're just starting, don't worry—all essentials are available on-site.

Is there an age requirement?

Generally, participants must be 18 or older, though some beginner or social leagues may allow younger players with parental consent.

Are spectators welcome?

Definitely! Friends, family, and fans are encouraged to attend matches, cheer on their favorites, and enjoy the lively atmosphere.

League Rules and Format

Each league operates under a clear set of rules (VNEA), designed to maintain competitive integrity and maximize enjoyment. General etiquette is emphasized, with a focus on fair play, respect between competitors, and promptness.

Team League

League schedules weekly matches, with cumulative team scores determining playoff positions.

Sessions

Active offers three team league sessions per year. Fall League starts in September, Spring starts in late April and Summer in July.

Skill Levels

Active offers 4 nights of league. Each night is a different level of skill. Tuesday night is the starting level. Wednesday is the Intermediate level
